Balance of social & emotional development to support academic growth.




Students become more comfortable and confident in their early literacy skills.

PREPARING FOR KINDERGARTEN

PRACTICING BUILDS CONFIDENCE!

- Singing & rhyming builds exposure to the sounds letters make
- Coloring, cutting, and building strengthen small fingers and hand-eye coordination.
- Recognizing colors and shapes in the world around them.
- Counting to 10 and recognizing numbers to five.
- Play with numbers and sorting objects.
- Recognizing and beginning to write his/her first and last name.
- Practicing life skills with independence (zippers, shoes, opening snack packages, etc).
- Turn taking and sharing.
