








OUR PROGRAM

PRACTICING BUILDS CONFIDENCE!

- Singing & rhyming builds exposure to the sounds letters make
- Coloring, cutting, and building strengthen small fingers and hand-eye coordination.
- Recognizing colors and shapes in the world around them.
- Counting to 10 and recognizing numbers to five.
- Play with numbers and sorting objects.
- Recognizing and beginning to write his/her first and last name.
- Practicing life skills with independence (zippers, shoes, opening snack packages, etc).
- Turn taking and sharing.

9:30 to 11 a.m.

Michigan requires students entering kindergarten to have the following screenings:

1. Vision
2. Hearing
3. Dental

Once application is approved, complete the Enrollment Process
